We may add that concerns have been raised with regards to sub point **15 (i)** regarding compulsory RTPCR tests for workers and the matter has been taken up in this regard. On a WhatsApp chat group for Industrial Association/Chamber, **Mr Santosh Deshmukh, SDO Shirur** has responded as under:-
