

Mr. Sinha started his career as entrepreneur, setting up a Press Shop named M/s Precision Pressing Manufactures and a Tool Room named M/s Pioneer Tool & Die Company in Bhosari Industrial Area, Pune in 1976. These companies are now major OEM suppliers to Bajaj and TVS group etc.

Presently he is the Managing Director of M/s San Stamping Pvt. Ltd., where they specialize in manufacture of spun parts from sheet metal for various application such as centrifugal separators, projectiles, liners, domes etc. made from diverse materials such as stainless steel, copper, aluminum, mild steel etc. They are OEM suppliers to multinational companies such as Alfa Laval, Tranter, Uni Klinger etc. and also to Ordinance Factories for defense purpose. Besides the above, they also export to OEM customers in Japan, USA, Italy, Germany, New Zealand, Australia etc.

Mr. Sinha is also founding Partner of Vastav Strategic Solutions LLP which provides consultancy to corporates in Strategic Planning, Legal, Financial, Operational, and IT related areas for manufacturing firms in the MSME Sector.

Apart from being an entrepreneur, Mr. Sinha is actively involved in social service since long. He was a member of Poona Round Table 65 for several years, twice as its President. He joined Rotary Club of Poona Downtown in 1993 and after holding various positions in the managing committee became President during the Centennial Year of Rotary in 2004-05. Through the Rotary Club he is associated with numerous CSR activities such as providing free prosthetic hand to victims of accidents who have lost a limb, providing oxygen concentrators for severely affected Covid patients free of cost etc. He is a founder member of Deccan Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture and has served as Hon. Secretary of the Chamber for many years.



More than 40 delegates attended the webinar.


WEBINAR ON" RBI GUIDELINES FOR EXPORTERS"

Adv. Mukund Kulkarni elaborately compared the various provisions of Factories Act 1948 as well as other Acts which are being amalgamated with the provisions of newly introduced OSH & WC Code. He specifically discussed the definitions of Skilled & unskilled workers, Establishment of trade, Industry, Business, Wages and provisions relating to Commencement & Cessation of Operation, Plan Approval & Licensing of Factory etc. The power point presentation given by Advocate Kulkarni is also enclosed.
