These awards celebrate excellence at individual and corporate level, and reflect the larger vision of corporate responsibility, innovation, and industrial progress.

Honouring Growth and Sustainability

Shri. Ashishkumar Chauhan congratulated the award winners in his address and commended DCCIA for recognizing industry leaders and public service officials. He emphasized the importance of industrialists and corporate entities in shaping India's economic future. Highlighting India's rapid industrial progress, he expressed optimism that the country is well on its way to becoming the third-largest economy in the world.

He further highlighted the numerous challenges entrepreneurs face, often without support from employees and vendors. He likened them to a movie makers where they are writer, director, producer, and lead character—sometimes even the sole spectator. Recalling past policies, he noted that in 1995-96, SMEs were allowed to raise funds from the stock market, but due to many companies vanishing, the practice was halted. It was reintroduced in 2012 with stringent regulations to support SME funding. He emphasized that stock exchange listing simplifies succession planning and aligns India with global business practices. Comparing a share certificate to a currency note, he stressed the responsibility of listed companies and the importance of strong corporate governance.

Looking Ahead: Future Plans and Initiatives

In his joint address to the gathering, **Rathin Sinha** highlighted that for the next year, the focus of DCCIA will be on cleanliness drives and traffic management to solve the traffic woes on Pune Nagar Road. He urged industry members to continue actively participating in training programmes, seminars, and business networking forums. They emphasized that India's industrial future is promising despite economic challenges, and businesses must adapt to emerging opportunities.

In his address, **H. P. Srivastava** recalled the Chamber's journey over 30 years and expressed his sincere thanks and gratitude to all stakeholders. "We aim to make this Industrial Belt a preferred investment destination. If we have to make India a 5 trillion economy, Maharashtra must contribute by being a trillion economy. To be there, we must ensure "Ease of Business" for every Industry. The operationalization of "The Maharashtra Trade & Investment Act 2023" through "The Maitri" portal should soon be a reality. Further, the government of Maharashtra will soon announce its new industrial policy, for which DCCIA has also given several suggestions. He added that it should also provide a significant boost to the industry.
