Sub:-Revised guidelines from Govt. of Maharashtra during extended period of lockdown till 31st May 2020.

Dear members,

Further to our email dated 17th May 2020 vide which we had forwarded the orders of the Government of Maharashtra extending the lockdown till 31st May 2020.

In line with the above, Government of Maharashtra has now released the revised guidelines during the extended period of lockdown till 31st May 2020.

As members will notice that Pune continues to be in "Red Zone" and the relaxations permitted in MHA guidelines of 17th May 2020 for Red Zone such as plying of Inter/Intra state buses and movement of 4 wheelers etc. have not been permitted in Government of Maharashtra guidelines. However, movement of 4 wheelers and 2 wheelers are permitted for essential services only.

Members are requested to refer Annexure 3 (also attached) for knowing as to what is permitted and what is not permitted under revised guidelines of GOM.

The night curfew for movement of individuals from 7 am to 7 pm continues except for essential activities.

We are also enclosing the guidelines on preventive measures to contain the spread of Covid in workplace which have been issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

The guidelines are quite helpful in providing details of measures to be taken in case of occurrence of cases among employees at work place. This was one major area of concern for Industries as there was no clarity in this regard.
